

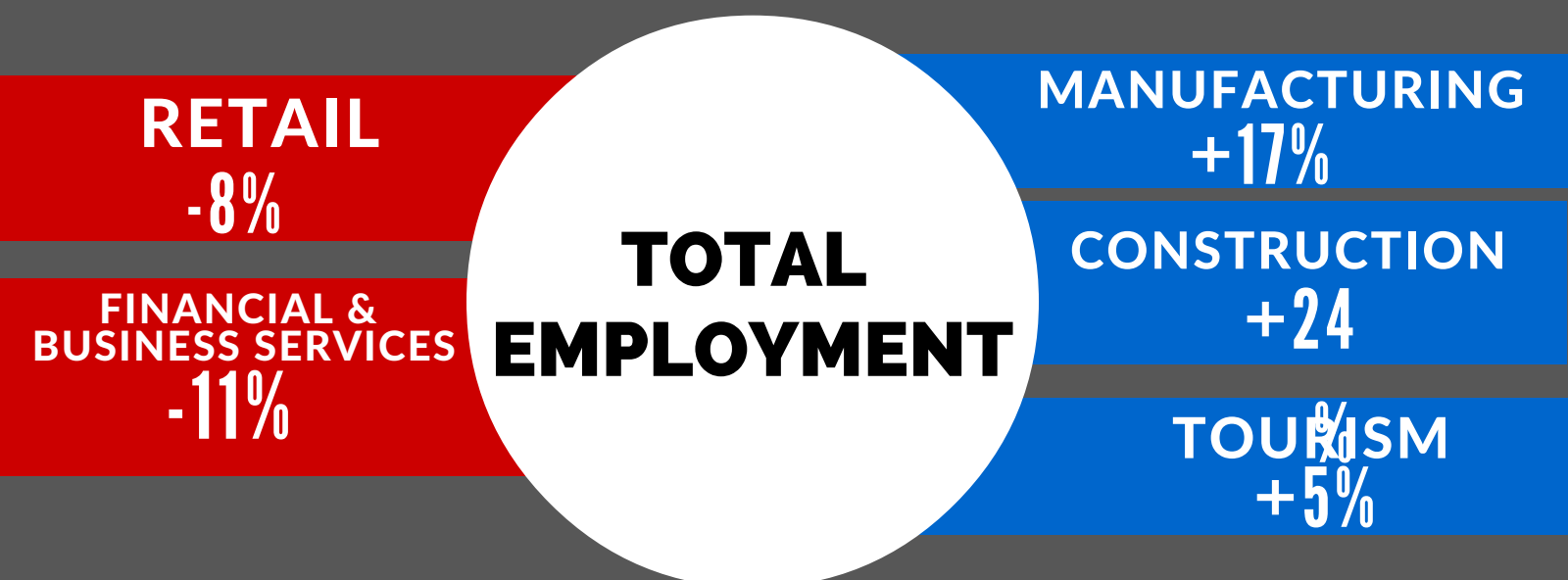


QUARTERLY ECONOMIC INDICATOR
